



# FISHING REGULATIONS 2021

Regulations valid from 1st January 2021 until 31st December 2021.

## I - Preamble

Saint-Cyr Lake is a closed water basin, open all year round to anyone wishing to practice fishing. Fishermen are required to comply with the internal regulations of the leisure park and the 2021 fishing regulations.

Bait boat and boilie cannon are strictly prohibited. All boats, whether motorized or rowing, are prohibited on the water, as well as « Float Tubes» type inflatable devices (except on float tubes themed days) in place.

Any fishing techniques, other than “No Kill” fishing is **strictly prohibited**. All fish species, except catfish, roach and bleak will be released.

Lure fishing is authorized, with respect for other fishermen. Live fishing is **prohibited**. The backlead is mandatory.

On the occasion of certain events on the leisure base and / or in the event of a thunderstorm, fishing may be prohibited from time to time by SAGA (Company managing the Saint-Cyr Leisure Park) in certain areas or over the entire lake.

Vehicles must be parked in the car parks provided for this purpose.

Courtesy towards other users of the lake, respect and cleanliness of the environment are essential. The removal of waste and trash remains the responsibility of the fisherman. It is strictly forbidden to cut trees, branches or make a fire.

## II - Opening times

Dominant fish species: white fish, carp, zander, pike.  
Fishing is open all year round.

## III - Day fishing

The “day fishing” rate gives access to fishing from sunrise to sunset with free placement and limits the fisherman to 3 MAXIMUM rods (one hook maximum with micro barb per rod for “No Kill” fishing).

In order to be able to practice the fishing activity during the day, the fishermen will have to pay a fishing right either at the reception of the campsite during the opening periods from April 1 to September 30 or at the parking meter located at the entrance to the campsite (payment by bank card only).

## IV - Night fishing

The “NIGHT” rates give access to the pitch by 24 hour time slot with free arrival.

In order to be able to practice the night fishing activity, fishermen must:

- for zones 1 & 2: pay a fishing fee, either at the reception of the campsite during opening hours or at the parking meter at the entrance of the campsite (payment by bank card only).
- for zone 3: compulsory reservation made beforehand for this zone with the fishing manager of the Saint-Cyr Park on 06 44 17 32 59 or on 05 49 62 57 22 depending on availability and events.

Green or “natural”, camo or bivvie tents are tolerated but maximum discretion is required. One tent or bivvies allowed per person

**V - Fishing areas 3 zones are reserved for fishing activity:**  
2 with free placement, and one with delimited fishing station



**VI - Minors customers and accompanying adults**

Underage customers must be accompanied by an adult for the duration of the activity. Accompanying persons are prohibited on the fishing stations (except derogation). Visitors who wish to accompany or visit a fisherman during the paid entry period must pay their entry fee.

**VII – Conditions and commitments of the fisherman**

The use of fixture that favour hooking to the fingerboard is recommended in order not to condemn a fish to certain death. Equipment recommended for carp anglers to return to the water: landing mattress. It is forbidden to be intoxicated or in states requiring the call of the police.

**VIII - 2021 Prices**

These rates are applicable from January 1 to December 31, 2021. They include entry to the leisure park during the summer period.

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### IX - Sanctions & compensation to damage caused

The staff of SAGA, the company managing the site, is in charge of monitoring and applying these regulations. Regulars controls on the site are carried out. During these controls, you must imperatively present your fishing rights up to date as well as an identity document.

In case of shortcomings, SAGA reserves the right to interrupt the session without reimbursement of the fishing rights. These regulations are posted on fishing zones. Any violation of the regulations will be penalized with penalty :

### Extract of Saint-Cyr Park's rules & regulations

#### Chapter 6: Fishing

Saint-Cyr Lake is a closed lake, open all year round to anyone wishing to practice a fishing activity. Catch & Release is the only technique allowed except for wels catfish and catfish,

**Article 1:** Anglers are asked to respect the zones designated by SAGA. Fishing is authorised in designated areas, which are demarcated and signposted. A map of the fishing zones, regulations and fishing rules are posted around the park.

**Article 2:** The federal fishing card is unnecessary. However, those wishing to fish at Saint-Cyr must pay for a fishing permit and adhere to the current regulations of the Park. They must also show, when asked, some form of documentation.

**Article 3:** The staff of SAGA, administrator of the site, is in charge of monitoring and enforcing these rules & regulations with the intervention of external authorities when necessary. Those repeatedly breaching these regulations will be ejected from the Park with no refund.

**Article 4:** Anglers are asked to adhere to the current general fishing regulations in the Vienne *département*, updated yearly with a *préfectoral* decree, taking into special consideration that of the size of the fish.

**Article 5:** Material necessary to fish in Saint-Cyr Lake :

- RODS: 3 rods maximum allowed per angler. When away from the swim, all lines must be pulled in. Never leave your rods unattended.
- UNHOOKING MAT: All anglers must be in possession of an unhooking mat, adapted in size to the type of fishing practiced.
- LANDING NET: All anglers must be in possession of a landing net, which must be of an adapted size.
- DISINFECTANT: All anglers must possess disinfectant. Caught fish must be treated with an antiseptic solution before being carefully returned to the water. Do not keep them in a fish cooler bag.
- LEADER: Only nylon fish lines are allowed for Catch & Release technique. Braided fish lines and butt sections are forbidden.
- TIPPET: the tippet must be heavier than the leader.
- HOOKS: Maximum hook size is No. 4. One fishhook or micro barb hook per rod allowed. The use of bait for carnivorous fish is authorised with barbless or filed barbed hooks.
- All rigging must ensure the safety of the fish. "Lead Core" lines are forbidden.
- BAIT: (subject to analysis made by Regional Health & Safety Agency)
- Light bait (made of biodegradable matter, natural flour based) is acceptable as well as other forms of bait (hard boiled wheat, maggots, worms, earthworms)
- Heavy bait is completely forbidden (crab, blood, earth, cooked products) as well as all types of grain. Only pellets, balls and cooked grains retail bought are allowed.
- Motorised baiting is not allowed in any part of Saint-Cyr Leisure Park.

Wading is allowed up to the waist and should not affect the swim of other anglers around you. Bait boats and are not authorised

SAGA reserves the right to check rigging used and material used.

Swimming and making fires are both forbidden.

**Article 6:** All small boats are forbidden in the water, except those deemed for security. Inflatable motorised boats like « Float Tubes » are not allowed in any part of the lake, exemption may apply from SAGA.

**Article 7:** Only fishing and baiting from the banks is allowed in areas designated for this purpose. The authorised banks are clearly marked as stipulated in article 1 of the regulations. Fishing is the responsibility of those practicing and theirs alone. Anglers should not, at any time, degrade the banks and must respect all activities that take place at Saint-Cyr Leisure Park.

**Article 8:** Serious injury caused to the fish, especially marking, is prohibited. Fish farming is also forbidden in all parts of the Saint-Cyr Lake and Leisure Park.

**Article 9:** Anglers are asked to leave the banks clean and not to throw any waste or fishing material into the lake.

**Article 10 :** All competition organization must obtain SAGA approval beforehand. During events organized by, or in partnership with SAGA, fishing areas may be changed to allow the smooth running of such events.
